

Joey & Kitty Class (1-2 years)

- enjoy using simple words that they learned in class (ex. circle time, activity, etc.)
- put 2 or 3 words together to express their wants and needs (ex. open please, wait please, my turn, thank you/no thank you, etc.)
- enjoy books, songs, finger plays, etc.

Koala Class (2-3 years)

- use simple words to communicate with friends and teachers
- understand the teacher's instructions
- ask questions and speak in short sentences to express themselves (ex. can I have it?, I'm using it, etc.)
- enjoy story lines of books, songs, and finger plays

Language and Speech Development

Dormouse Class (3-4 years)

- expose to books, reading materials, songs and finger plays that stimulate language
- explore books and illustrations on their own to expand their imagination and thinking skills
- use their words to express their feelings and to communicate with their friends and teachers
- share stories with details and enthusiasm (ex. family, friends, something they experienced)
- speak in complete sentences and express ideas clearly

Armadillo Class (4-6 years)

- use language effectively to express ideas, thoughts, and feelings while interacting with friends and teachers
- develop skills of speaking in front of people (ex. show and tell, presentation, etc.)
- acknowledge the sense of time (ex. past, present, future)
- enjoy language play, songs, rhymes and jokes
- discuss about stories and books while showing understanding of the story line
- be able to tell concepts and summarize
- participate in creative, dramatic, and choral speaking
- involve in class discussion
